CLASS 1 **Novice Pony Jumping** - 14.2hh and under; jumps 60cm / 2'
Combination of rider and pony not to have won more than £10

CLASS 2 **Novice Horse Jumping** - 14.3hh and over; jumps 60cm / 2'
Combination of rider and horse not to have won more than £10

CLASS 3 **Pairs Relay** - jumps 60cm / 2'
No Horse/Pony may be entered more than once

CLASS 4 **Horse/Pony Jumping** - jumps 70cm / 2' 3"

CLASS 5 **Intermediate Jumping** - jumps 80cm / 2' 6"

CLASS 6 **Open Jumping** - jumps 90cm / 3'

Child 10 years and under. To qualify for the RLS riders not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st Jan in the current year; ponies must be registered and not exceed 122cms

CLASS 9 * **First Ridden Pony**
Child 12 years and under. Show to include only walk and trot; no lead rein. To qualify for the RLS riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st Jan in the current year; ponies must be registered and not exceed 128cm

CLASS 11 **Prettiest Mare** (Ridden, on or off the lead rein)

CLASS 13 * **Veteran Horse/Pony** (In Hand) – 16 years and older

CLASS 14 * **Any Coloured Horse/Pony** (In Hand)

CLASS 15 * **Mountain and Moorland, Shetland (Miniature/Standard)** (In Hand)
Registered and Unregistered small and large breeds – only registered can qualify for RLS. Class may be split into large and small breeds depending on entries

CLASS 16 * **Veteran Horse/Pony** (Ridden) – 16 years and older

CLASS 17 * **Any Coloured Horse/Pony** (Ridden)

Royal London Show 1st, 2nd & 3rd placed horse/pony not already qualified in eligible classes will qualify for the Champion of Britain Title classes to be held at the RLS in 2017. Each qualified horse/pony will receive a qualification card in the ring (or can be collected from the Secretary's tent) which will enable the owner to enter the RLS, provided the owner and rider/handler are or become registered with the International Showing Society within 28 days of the qualifying show. Clear Round Jumping Times:

09.00 to 10.00: jumps 45cm / 1' 6"

10.00 to 11.00: jumps 40cm / 1' 3"

11.00 to 12.00 noon: jumps 15cm / 6"

CLASS 29 will start at 12.00 noon

Combinations of Horse/Pony and rider who have competed in Ring 1 are not eligible to compete in CLASSES 29 to 34

Heights of jumps are approximate

CLASS 29 **Mini Mini Jumping** - jumps 15cm / 6"
Child 12 years and under; may be led

CLASS 30 **Hoof and Foot** - jumps 15cm / 6"
Child 14 years and under; may be led
Child and pony jump one round then child dismounts and jumps a shortened course on foot without the pony. Both rounds will be timed

CLASS 31 **Mini Jumping** - jumps 30cm / 1'
May be led

CLASS 32 **Absolute Novice Pony** - 14.2hh and under; jumps 45cm / 1' 6"
Combination of rider and pony not to have won more than £10

CLASS 33 **Absolute Novice Horse** - 14.3hh and over; jumps 55cm / 1' 9"
Combination of rider and horse not to have won more than £10

CLASS 34 **Senior Jumping** - jumps 60cm / 2'
Rider 30 years or older

Rules

1. The Judge's decision is final
2. A hard hat must be worn which meets British Standards according to the BHS
3. Body Protectors to BETA standards are strongly recommended
4. Jackets to be worn when showing and jumping
5. No entry money will be refunded except on production of a veterinary or doctor's certificate
6. In the event of a dispute a height certificate for horse/pony may be required
7. Any objections should be lodged in writing with the Secretary within 30 minutes of the incident in question, together with a deposit of £10. The deposit will be forfeited unless the objection is sustained
8. Competitors who fall off in any ring will be asked to leave the ring leading their horse/pony
9. Horse/pony abuse will result in elimination
10. NORC reserve the right to ask any person to leave the show ground without stating a reason
11. All litter is to be taken home
12. Cantering around the car park or show ground is strictly forbidden. Please use the practice areas provided
13. No horse/pony under 4 years old may compete in the ridden classes
14. In the event of cancellation of the show for any reason 25% of entry fees may be retained to cover administration costs
